Morgan Title IV Authorization Form

When a school disburses student aid funds to a student's account, it is only allowed to do so for current year allowable charges (as defined in section 472 of the Higher Education Act of 1965). Allowable charges are tuition, fees, and room/board. Funds in excess of this are to be paid directly to the student.

Charges that are not allowable are library fines, parking tickets, prior year balances etc. however, students are allowed to Title IV Student Financial Aid funds to pay their charges if the student authorizes this in writing. If the student is dependent, the parent's signature is also required.
