



ILLEGAL DOWNLOADING STANDARDS AND SANCTIONS

The Morgan network is continuously monitored. Illegal downloading of music, videos, or other copyrighted material constitutes an infringement of federal law. Under this law, the University is responsible for preventing illegal copyrighting. Illegal downloading is an infraction of the Morgan State University Computer Use Policy and a violation of the Code of Student Conduct. Sanctions for such violations will result in a suspension of network privileges or even fines. Repeat violators will be referred to the Morgan State University Office of Judicial Affairs.

Violators doing illegal downloading receive an on-screen warning that their network use will be suspended for a set time period.

Students in Residence Halls whose network privileges are permanently suspended must see their Resident Director if they wish to have these privileges restored. An incident report will be forwarded to Judicial Affairs.

The Morgan Network is for authorized users only. Wireless networks that are not operated by the University are strictly prohibited by the State of Maryland and the University's standard security practice.

To avoid suspension of network privileges and penalties, please abide by the University Computer Use Policy.
