The 2020 STI takes place from July 6 to July 31 — and it's free!

Participants will meet new friends and mentors, get useful tips for applying to college and experience life on a college campus. The STEM program also features SAT prep and activities that promote self-awareness.

STI is free.

Students receive a full scholarship that covers the entire cost of the program, including all lab fees and field trips.

Lunch and bus passes are also provided daily. Held on Morgan's campus, the program meets Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Upon completion, each participant receives a \$250 stipend.

The National Transportation Center at Morgan State University is now accepting applications for its 24th annual Summer Transportation Institute (STI).

STI introduces teens to career opportunities in transportation and engineering. The program features four weeks of exciting field trips, hands-on projects and networking opportunities with industry professionals.

Who can attend?

Applicants should be entering 10th, 11th or 12th grade during the 2020-2021 school year; have completed or be qualified to enroll in prealgebra; and have at least a 2.5 GPA.

How do you apply?

Students must submit

 a completed application. Applications can be found online at

- an official transcript (rising 10th-graders submit third-quarter report cards)
- a 700 word essay that describes their career goals, interest in transportation, and how STI can help them achieve their goals.



Essays must be typed and double spaced.

- one letter of recommendation from a math, science, or technology teacher.
- An orientation for accepted applicants will be held on June 29.

Applications are being accepted from March 6 - May 29, 2020.
