July 1 to July 30, 2021



The 2021 NSTI is VIRTUAL and FREE -- from July 1 to July 30

Simulation and virtual participation give students a chance to explore what life is like -- digitally -- on a college campus. Participants can safely meet new friends online, gain mentors, and get tips on applying to college. The STEM-based NSTI also features SAT prep and activities that promote self-awareness.

NSTI is free.

Students receive a full scholarship that covers the entire cost of the program. Held virtually, STI meets Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Upon completion, each participant receives a stipend.

Who can attend?

Applicants should be entering grades 7th through 12th, during the 2020-2021 school year; have completed or be qualified to enroll in pre-algebra; and have at least a 2.5 GPA.

How do you apply?

Students must submit an online application that includes

uploading:

- an official transcript (middle school students and rising 10th-graders submit third-quarter report cards)
- a 700-word essay that describes their career goals, interest in transportation, and how STI can help them achieve their goals. Essays must be typed and double spaced.
- one letter of recommendation from a math, science, or technology teacher.

An orientation for accepted applicants will be held on July 1 and 2. The deadline for applications has been extended to **June 4, 2021**.

NSTI introduces students to career opportunities in transportation and engineering. The program features four weeks of exciting virtual field trips, hands-on projects and networking opportunities with industry professionals.
