

REHABILITATION SPECIALIST

The primary functions of the Rehabilitation Specialist shall be to supervise and train a team of Rehabilitation Coordinators and perform all casework duties on a day-to-day basis. The Rehabilitation Specialist shall be report to the Program Director regarding day-to-day management of the clients and their treatment plans. The Rehabilitation Specialist's tasks shall be inclusive of, but not be limited to, the following:

- Coordinate in the creation and implementation of Individual Rehabilitation Plans;
- Development, implementation and maintenance of rehabilitation contact notes and monthly and quarterly summaries;
- Discharge recommendations and summaries;
- Identify and address the client's rehabilitation needs;
- Incident reports;
- Development of in home strategies including goal setting, planning and decision making
- Perform life skills training;
- Perform life skills groups;
- Perform staff training and supervision;
- Crisis Intervention:
- Participate in clinical training, supervision treatment teams and other clinical and educational activities;
- Develop and implement individual service modalities tailored to the specific needs of her clients; and
- Supervise social work interns as appropriate.

All other duties necessary in the continued operation of the company

SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

- 1. Ability to prepare formal reports, make appropriate recommendations, and record pertinent information regarding the clients on a day-to-day basis.

- 3. Minimum of 2 years direct care experience working with emotionally disturbed youth.
