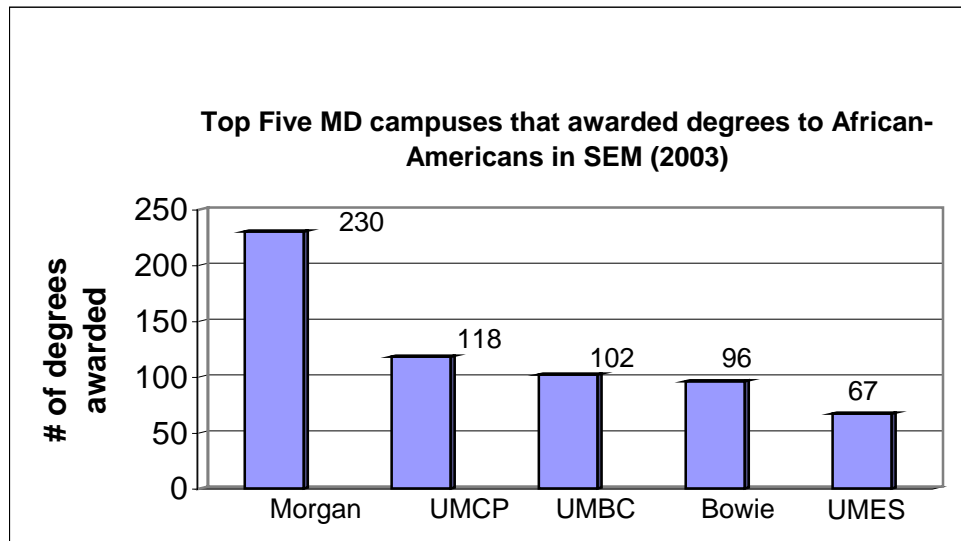
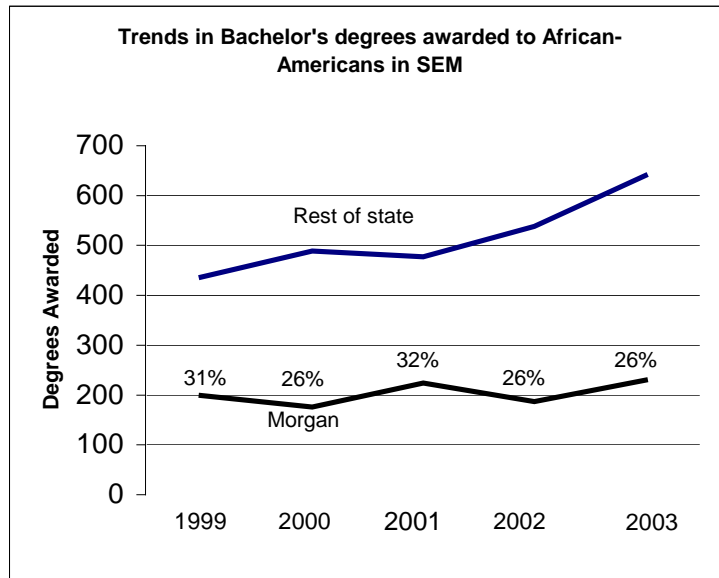




Bachelor's Degrees Awarded to African-Americans in Science, Engineering and Math

Over the past five years, Morgan has averaged over a quarter of the state's Bachelor's degrees awarded to African-Americans in science, engineering and math (SEM). This is despite offering only the basic programs in these fields. In 2003, Morgan awarded nearly twice as many bachelor's degrees in SEM fields as the second leading campus, UMCP. Among SEM fields, Morgan awarded over 40% of those degrees statewide in engineering and physical sciences.
