Hopkins-HBCU Biomedical Engineering (BME) Pathway  
INTERNSHIP APPLICATION**  
Deadline: March 1, 2024

This is third year of an internship program including Johns Hopkins, Morgan State, and Coppin State, which will provide students at MSU and CSU an opportunity to work in a research lab at Hopkins. The program contains three components: (1) Spring 2024 for onboarding to set student expectations, student participation in lab meetings and preparation for summer research; (2) Summer 2024 for research over a 10-week period in a lab at Hopkins with a \$5000 stipend; and (3) Fall 2024 for reporting of the research performed, including student-directed data analysis and synthesis, and process training for a scholarly publication. Interviews with potential mentor(s) are handled on a case-by-case basis. Applicants will be interviewed by interested faculty mentors, and the start date of the internship will be around the first week of June.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident (international students are not eligible to apply)
2. Currently enrolled full-time at MSU or CSU (sophomore, junior or non-graduating senior)
3. Majoring in engineering, computer science, biology, chemistry, or math
4. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0

Please note: Because of the close proximity to MSU, housing is not included. Participants are expected to have their own transportation to and from JHU. Thus, living in close proximity either on or off the MSU campus is suggested.
