ADVANCED PLACEMENTS

PART A

Morgan State University awards advanced placement and/or degree credits for certain college-level courses based on the results high school students may obtain on some of the College Entrance Examination Board Advanced Placement Examinations. A list of credits which are acceptable by Morgan State University has been included in the following chart. Students desiring to receive credit for advanced placement examinations should request that the examination scores be sent to the Office of Admissions at Morgan State University (CEEB) by writing to:

PART B

Additionally, advanced placement may be awarded for credits earned by high school students in selected University courses upon enrolling as a matriculating student at Morgan State University. Under certain circumstances, high school students classified as junior or seniors, with a grade point average of 3.00 or better and letter of recommendation from high school principal, may be granted permission to take university coursework. These students will receive certifications of completion for each course taken. Upon matriculation at Morgan State University the student will be granted advanced placement.
