Revisions to Policy on Course Load Limits Per Semester and Summer

Class Load Limits

The regular class load for students in good standing is 18 except for students majoring in Engineering where the regular class load is 19 credits. Authorization for loads in excess of 18 credits must be secured from the Dean of the school or college in which a student is enrolled. The class load limit for students on probation is 13 credits.

Summer Program

The summer session offers courses in selected fields of study. All credits earned will be applied toward the appropriate degree, provided all other requirements are met. The maximum number of credits that may be pursued at Morgan per summer session is eight (8). Authorization for loads in excess of 8 credits must be secured from the Dean of the school or college in which a student is enrolled.

Non-Morgan students must contact the Office of Continuing Studies for admission to the University prior to registration for the summer session. These students may pursue a maximum of 8 credits per summer session at Morgan State University and have their credits transferred back to their institutions. The students are encouraged to obtain prior approval for courses from their institution prior to registration.
