

EDUCATIONAL LEAVE POLICY

We are endeavoring to take advantage of every opportunity to lessen the impact of retrenchment on the affected faculty. Retrenched faculty pursuing doctoral studies or interested in retooling for career changes have been encouraged to use this year for full-time study on educational leave.

For the duration of the retrenchment, Board approval is requested for a waiver of the existing policy on educational leave to permit full pay rather than partial payment for faculty affected by retrenchment.
