Re: Update on Payroll Modernization Project

Dear Maryland State Agency and University Representatives:

Greetings! Spring will be here soon, and flowers will in the places previously occupied by snow!

As discussed during the Payroll Modernization Monthly Update meeting on February 12, 2026 (see attached meeting PowerPoint), we are implementing additional multi-factor authentication measures for our Payroll Online Service Center (POSC) site to protect employee information and payroll data.

Beginning March 30, 2026, POSC will send users a secure PIN to the email address registered with POSC when they attempt to log in. This means all employees must have a valid email address in POSC; otherwise, they will not receive a PIN and will not be able to access POSC. It is imperative that all agencies contact both current and former employees to log in and ensure they have a valid email address on record as soon as possible. Your support in ensuring employees update their email addresses promptly is critical to the success of these security enhancements.


